Total Credit Requirement to Graduate: 220

Students will receive 5 credits per semester for each course passed with a pass (P) or D- or better. There are two semesters, Fall and Spring, in the school year. Students generally can earn 60 credits for each year.

In 4 years, most students accumulate 240 credits

SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS

ENGLISH: 40 CREDITS (4 YEARS)

Students are required to be enrolled in an English class for the 9th - 12th grades.

MATH: 20 CREDITS (2 YEARS)

Must pass two consecutive years of standard based Math at two different increasing levels including 1 year of Integrated Math 1 or higher.

PHYSICAL SCIENCE: 20 CREDITS (2 YEARS)

Students are required to be enrolled in PE in the 9th and 10th grade P.E.
